


## 2023 Financials Overview

- The Association has not yet returned to pre-pandemic revenue levels
  - New patterns of membership professional development needs & demands
- Modest revenue growth in NAEM Programs
  - Travel restrictions and inflationary cost increases continue
- Another year of strong membership growth
  - Alongside higher than usual member turnover
- The Association's operating expenses were tightly controlled



# NAEM Financials: Operational Revenue & Expenses


3-Year View
