


Demographics

- Research findings based on responses from 67 Sustainability Leaders
- Over 80% of respondents had a revenue over \$1 Billion
- Half of respondents were manufacturers
- Three quarters of respondents were from Business to Business (B2B) companies




Companies are Focusing on Employee Health






ESG Reporting Remains a High Priority






B2C vs B2B ESG Prioritization

B2B & B2C ESG Prioritization







Delays are Due to Manpower and Shifted Focus




Employee Health and Safety B2B B2C Comparison





Sustainability Function: Budgets Unchanged


Sustainability Budget Impacts
