

#### Today's Business Risks Facing EHS Leaders










#### **Survey Demographics**

Most Respondents work in corporations with annual revenues over \$1B and most have headquarters in the United States









#### A Range of Business Risks to Consider

Disruption to work environments/productivity	38%	21%	41%
Loss of customers/sales	41%	34%	25%






