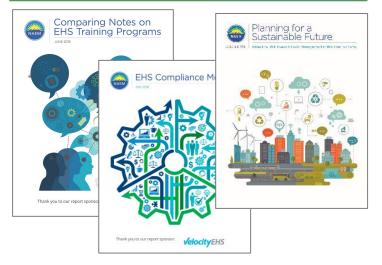



BMS Sustainability Journey

Near-term SBT Long-term SBT

Starting in 2001 we set our first sustainability targets with a goal year of 2005 and every 5 years after that other goals were set (2010, 2015, 2020).



As of August 2023, there are 30 Site (Manuf./R&D/Warehouse and offices) for which we report on sustainability performance

CG = Capital goods
FERA = Fuel- and energy-related activities
PG&S = Purchased goods and services
UT&D = Upstream transportation and distribution

^{*}The 55% overall reduction results in a 4.96% linear annual reduction rate from 2022 to 2033. **70% of emissions from PG&S, CG, and UT&D represent ~62% of total Scope 3 emissions, which in combination with emissions from FERA (~5%), get BMS past the Scope 3 near-term SBT coverage requirement (67%).

Business Integrated

Full integration of sustainability into business strategy, planning, and operational excellence



Value Creation & Risk Mitigation

Maturing data management processes, supply chain focus and analytics allow for advancements in identifying risks and value opportunities. Implementing corporate governance.



Purpose Driven

Initial purpose-driven business process and technology that drives data quality and timeliness. Business risks are defined, and opportunities start to emerge. Public disclosures become standard practice. Focus on product lifecycle analyses and external data. Initial governance activities.



Reactive

Collecting metrics data of varying quality, transparency, and accuracy. Limited strategy and public disclosure. Inquisitive start to supply chain. Uninformed goals are set based on external pressures. Focus is compliance with regulatory frameworks.
